

## LOTTO SKYWORKS 2002

This WARSUG guide is for scanning the Lotto Skyworks 2002. The information in here is mostly guesswork as it's usually next to impossible to find out the correct channel allocations until the afternoon of the event. Based on past years however, we can make an "educated guess" on what to listen to.

*Note: On the talkback frequency, you will probably hear only the operator in the 92.9 studio, you won't hear the announcer.*

*The cues are short "beep" sounds to trigger the release of each firework. There may also be some voice traffic before the start of the Skyshow.*

*Note: After the SkyWorks has finished, you'll hear lots of activity on the Westrail channels as the exodus of people reaches the City train station... Some of the callsigns you may hear are:*

*CSO (Customer Service Officer), CSA (Assistant), Sabre (Security), SSO (Security Services Officer at a station), Trainrider (on-train security) and Rev (Revenue Protection or Ticket Inspectors).*

## PUBLISHED ROAD CLOSURES

**KINGS PARK** - All roads in Kings Park will be closed all day on Australia Day.

**CITY OF PERTH** - Riverside Drive from the Causeway to Mounts Bay Road will be closed from 12 noon to 10.30pm. This will include the Riverside Drive freeway exit ramp.

**ACCESS TO CITY OFF MITCHELL FREEWAY**- Southbound traffic on the Mitchell Freeway can access the City via the Vincent Street and James Street exits.

**ACCESS TO CITY FROM KWINANA FREEWAY** - The footbridge and two outside lanes closed at 5pm.

Access will be available via the Mounts Bay Road, Hay Street West or Market Street exits.

**KWINANA FWY NORTHBOUND** - The Mill Point Road exit ramp to South Perth will be closed to all traffic from 6am to 10.30pm.

**KWINANA FWY SOUTHBOUND** - The Mill Point Road exit ramp to South Perth will be closed from 4pm to 10.30pm and South Terrace from 8pm.

**NARROWS BRIDGE** - Closed 7.50pm to 8.45pm.

**CITY OF SOUTH PERTH** - The following roads in South Perth will be closed from 6am to 8.30pm. Mill Point Close - east of Mill Point Road. Queen Street. Fraser Lane. Ferry Street. Harper Terrace. Mends Street. Darley Street. Coode Street - north of Mill Point Road. Douglas Avenue - north of Jubilee Street. South Perth Esplanade. Mill Point Road - north of Kwinana freeway off ramp. Melville parade, Melville Place, Stirling Street, Scott Street, Stone Road.

**VICTORIA PARK** - Taylor Street and adjoining laneways will be closed from 9am north west of Canning Highway.

**DURING LOTTO SKYWORKS 2002** - The Kwinana and Mitchell freeways between Canning Highway and Graham Farmer Freeway will be closed from 7.50pm to 8.45pm.

**AFTER LOTTO SKYWORKS 2002** - Malcolm Street and Kings Park Road, between Havelock Street and Harvest Terrace, will be closed for a period to allow spectators to leave Kings Park safely. The CBD bounded by the foreshore, Milligan Street, Wellington Street and Victoria Avenue will be closed from 8.30pm to allow safe pedestrian access to the Railway Station. Traffic will be directed by Police to ensure minimum delays and safe egress from the City and South Perth.

Kwinana Freeway South entry via the two temporary ramps at Stirling Street and South Terrace in South Perth will be open for public egress. At 8pm the Kwinana Freeway Southbound off ramp at South Terrace will be closed for a period to assist exit from Labouchere Road and South Terrace.
